"THE LEGACY" PRODUCTION RIDER

This Production rider (the "Production Rider") is attached to and made part of the contract (the "Contract") and rider (the "Rider") between THE LEGACY TOUR ("Artist") and the purchaser of said services ("Purchaser") as defined in the face of the contract in connection with Artist's performances(s) at the venue(s) described therein (the "Venue" or the "Engagement") Purchaser hereby agrees to the following additional terms and conditions: Purchaser shall provide and pay for the following:

1. AIR TRANSPORTATION

One (1) Business Class, Eleven (11) Coach-class tickets

The entire band will be booked on the same flight. All will travel together as a complete unit unless the Artist gives permission to the contrary. All flights should be non-stop, direct flights, unless no other option is available. All tickets must be booked in the legal names of the members and from/to the cities as listed on the personnel list for airline reservations. The entire crew comes from a different city please coordinate with the Tour manager. All travel and hotel must be approved PRIOR to reservations or ticketing.

2. HOTEL

Hotel must be rated a four (4) star or better with 24-hour room service and free WiFi. Accommodations are as follows:

Eleven (11) Single Rooms One (1) Suite

3. GROUND TRANSPORTATION

Two (2) 15 passenger vans will be required to handle all cast, luggage and equipment (both vans should have the back seat out). **THESE VEHICLES NEED TO BE AVAILABLE THE DAY WE ARRIVE, SHOW DAY AND UNTIL OUR DEPARTURE**. Please provide 2 baggage handlers to assist with all luggage and equipment. The vehicles requested will provide all ground transportation, beginning with airport pick-up and ending with airport drop-off at departure time. This includes, but not limited to sound check, performance and any other appearances (i.e. radio, TV, etc) in conjunction with the promotion of said performance(s).

4. SECURITY

We suggest three (3) at the front of stage and one (1) in the wing/side of stage. If the venue is not set up to support security at the front of stage, then two (2) people on each wing/side of the stage.

5. DRESSING ROOMS / OFFICES

Please provide two (2) large, clean dressing rooms and one (1) separate dressing room with separate bathrooms, hot and cold running water and toilets. Air conditioned or heated (as weather requires). Each room must be will lit, have electrical outlets, a full-length mirror and garment racks. Rooms must be close to or adjacent to the stage.

6. CATERING/DRESSING ROOM REQUIREMENTS

Promoter to provide Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner for all Legacy staff/artists as well as local crew. Legacy staff/artist numbers ten (10). No Fast Food. All meals should be hot meals.

There should be nonstop beverage service all day. This should include coffee, tea, bottled water and a variety of soft drinks and juices. Prior to performance, Forty-eight (48) bottles of water to be provided in wardrobe area of stage. Please consult with tour manager for this location.

7. AUDIO REQUIREMENTS

a) FRONT OF HOUSE (see input list for details)

1) FOH CONSOLE

Digidesign Profile or D-Show (1st choice) or Allen & Heath dLive 7000 w/CDM64 Mix Rack (2nd Choice)

2) CONSOLE POSITION

Must be stage centered and placed the length of the venue and should not be further than 90' from the stage. The console must be free from any obstructions. Locations in the rear of the venue, under balcony, or sound booth are frowned upon.

3) PA STACKS

Must consist line array (NEXO, V-DOSC, JBL OR VERTEC) Speakers must be aligned and summed in-phase with a linear flat frequency response from 30hz to 18khz. Must have near fills that are full range two-way side fill cabinets. No near fills that are the size of wedges. The near fills need to be independent (with separate graphic eq's) and run from front of house.

4) PA AMPLIFICATION

There must be enough professional amplification (Crown, QSC) to maintain a clean, undistorted 102db stereo program level (110db peak SPL) monitored at the FOH mix position. The amplification must be mounted in a fan-cooled rack, which is accessible by the audio engineer.







Option 2 (a walkway is req behind backline, as in option 1 and walkway between Bass & GtrSR)


